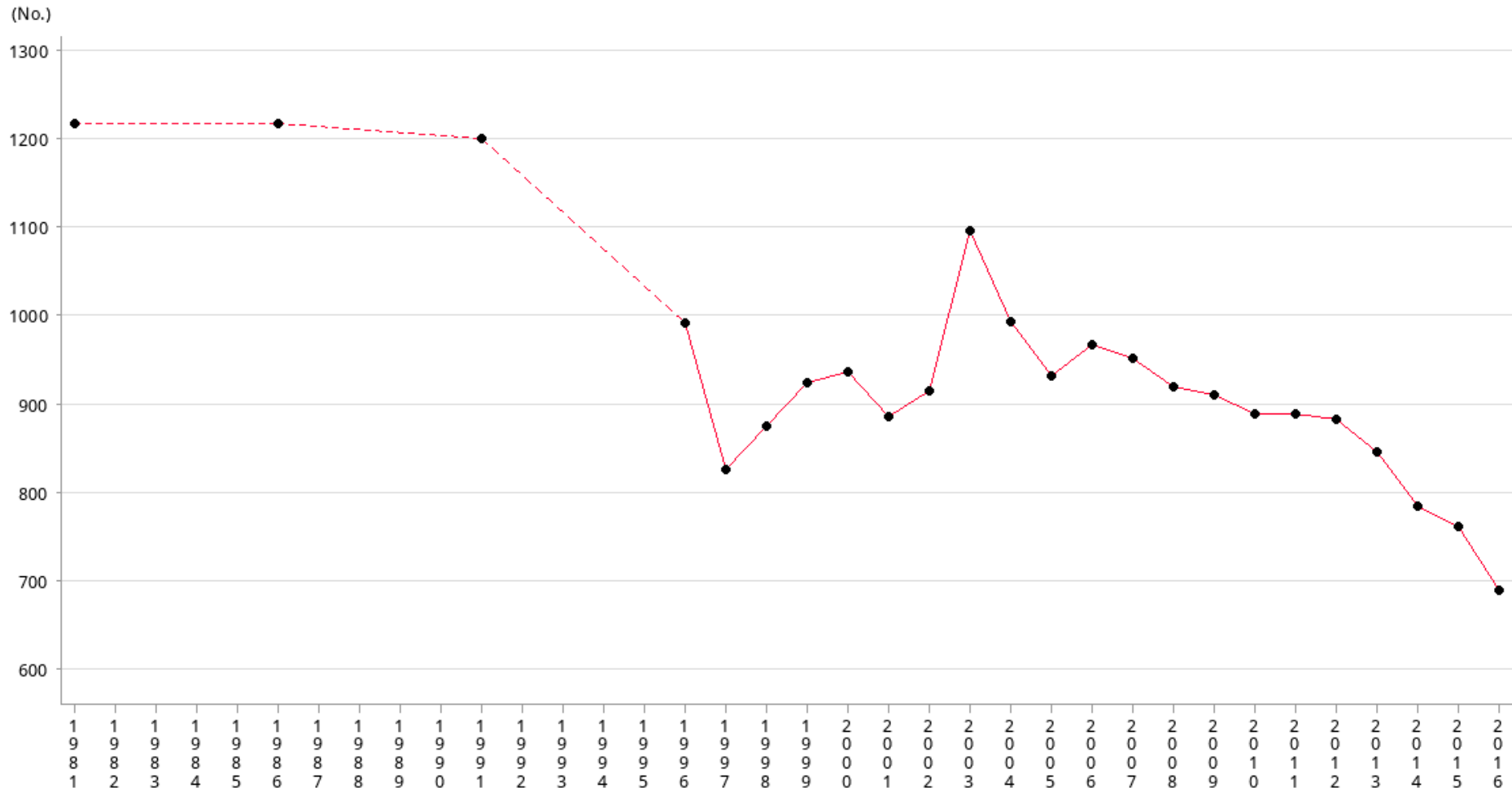

Operational Definitions

The number of non-violent crimes reported to the Hong Kong Police Force per 100,000 population. Non-violent crimes include burglary, theft and handling stolen goods, fraud and forgery, sexual offences, serious narcotics offences, offences against lawful authority, serious immigration offences, miscellaneous crimes including criminal damage, other offences against person, disorder/fighting in public place, offences against public order, unlawful society offences, money lending, serious gambling offences, conspiracy, object dropped from height and other non-violent crime.
